3. Carrier Common Line Access Service

The Telephone Company will provide Carrier Common Line Access Service (CCL) to customers.

3.1 General Description

Carrier Common Line Access provides for the use of Telephone Company common lines by customers for access to end users to furnish intrastate service.

Carrier Common Line Access is provided where the customer obtains Telephone Company Switched Access Service under this tariff.

The Carrier Common Line (CCL) rate element is associated with Switched Access feature groups addressed in Section 6.

Bulk Bill Carrier Common Line charges apply to all ICCs that furnish intrastate interexchange communications services within the State of Alaska. The ICC is required to pay the rates and charges specified herein for benefits and services provided by the Telephone Company, irrespective of the manner of connection. The charges are determined based on the proportion of Access Minutes of Use of any ICC, relative to the total Access Minutes of Use by all ICCs combined.

- C. Directory listings are not included in the rates and charges for Carrier Common Line Access.
- D. Intercept arrangements are not included in the rates and charges for Carrier Common Line Access.
- E. All line side connections provided in the same combined access group will be limited to the same features and operating characteristics.
- F. All trunk side connections provided in the same combined access group will be limited to the same features and operating characteristics.

3.3 Undertaking of the Telephone Company

Where the ICC is provided with Switched Access Service under other sections of this tariff, the Telephone Company will provide the use of Telephone Company common lines by an ICC for access to end users. Bulk Bill rates and charges are set forth in 13.1 following, in accordance with the regulations as set forth in 3.6 following. (C)

3.4 Obligations of the Customer (Cont'd) (C)

- B. The ICC facilities at the premises of the ordering ICC shall provide the necessary on-hook and off-hook supervision.
- C. Reserved for Future Use.
- D. The charges for Carrier Common Line Bulk Bill service shall be determined as set forth in 3.6 following. (C)
- E. The ICCs will provide Monthly Bulk Bill Reports to the AECA and the APUC. These reports will include information as described in Section 3.5 and such other information as may be required by the APUC. Forms will be available from the AECA as approved by the APUC, indicating the required information. These forms will be used for filing Monthly Bulk Bill Reports and will be supplemented as necessary with attachments or addenda. (C)
- F. The reports required under Section 3.5 must be submitted by the ICC to the AECA and the APUC no more than 5 working days following the last day of each month. The reporting period for the bulk bill switched access minutes will be from the 20th to the 19th of the next month. (C)

If the ICC does not furnish the reports to the AECA, the AECA shall estimate the ICC's percent market share in accordance with Section 3.5.3.

- G. The information provided in the reports required in Section 3.6 shall reflect the best data available as of the time each monthly report is prepared. If actual data is unavailable for certain categories (except where other provisions of this tariff require specific assumptions to be applied), an estimate will be provided in accordance with Section 3.6. Revised information will be filed when it becomes available. Any corrections or other revisions to actual data reported to the AECA should be reported as soon as possible. An ICC shall provide the AECA reasonable justification for any adjustments or corrections to information filed in a Monthly Bulk Bill Report, including:
- a. A Monthly Bulk Bill Report that shows the last reported total minutes to be adjusted.
 - b. A Monthly Bulk Bill Report that shows the adjustment to the minutes.
 - c. A Monthly Bulk Bill Report that shows the corrected total minutes.
 - d. A brief narrative explanation of the adjustment and its causes.
- H. Each of the reports required in Section 3.6 will be signed by an authorized representative of the ICC verifying that he/she is familiar with the contents thereof, and that such information is true and correct to the best of his/her information, knowledge, and belief.

When the ICC fails to provide information required for the Bulk Bill, an estimate of the minutes to be used for the Bulk Bill or Common Line market share computation (T) will be made by AECA as follows:

1. The estimate will be based on the prior submissions and/or other known and measurable observations at the time of the estimate.
2. The estimate will not be a detailed estimate, but will be completed in order to issue the bill on a timely basis.
3. When developing the estimate, AECA may base its analysis on a worst-case basis to preclude underestimation of the ICC's minutes.

3.6 Rate Regulation

- A. The Carrier Common Line Access Charge will be billed to each ICC under this tariff in accordance with the regulations as set forth below.
- B. The RCA shall determine the total dollar amount of the Bulk Bill Revenue Requirement to be recovered from the ICC pursuant to this tariff. AECA will continue to use this amount in calculating the total flat monthly charges payable under this tariff until it is superseded by a subsequent order of the RCA.
- C. Bulk Bill access charges are determined for each ICC by calculating percentages that provide a measure of the individual ICC's relative share of the intrastate interexchange market. The percentages are calculated as follows:

First, the Access Minutes of Use are reported through the Monthly Bulk Bill Report.

Next, each ICC's Access Minutes of Use is divided by the total Access Minutes of Use of all ICCs to determine each ICC's percent of the total.

The monthly bulk bill access charge applied to each ICC is equal to the total of monthly Bulk Bill Revenue Requirement (as set forth in Section 13.1.2) less the monthly revenue derived from the Network Access Fee and less any billed CCL monthly revenues associated with the Special Access Surcharge multiplied by the ICC's percentage of the total Access Minutes of Use.

- D. Bulk Bill charges will be recalculated to take into account any changes or corrections in minutes made for any ICC. An ICC must report billing or minute adjustments to AECA on or before 18 months have passed from the date the Monthly Bulk Bill Report was due.

AECA will adjust each ICC's appropriate prior monthly bill to account for any over or under payments made during the previous eighteen month period. The net effect of these adjustments will be reflected in the next month's bill as a separate line item. The penalty provisions in the tariff will only apply to any unpaid portion of a bill assessed by the AECA after an ICC refuses to pay a bill underpaid from prior periods as a result of adjustments reported to and made by the AECA. The interest shall be collected by the AECA and paid to those entitled to receive a credit in accordance with Section 2.4.1 (B)(2)(C). Once the AECA receives payment for a billing adjustment, it will immediately issue payment to those entitled to a credit. The AECA will not withhold these funds until it can issue its standard monthly bill.

E. The Commission may investigate flagrant or continued abuses of the adjustment provisions of the tariff and impose penalties where appropriate.

F. The AECA will issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) to obtain professional services to conduct annual audits of all ICCs for the first two years the bulk bill system is in operation.

Billing for the audit will occur in the following manner:

AECA will bill an ICC for its share of the monthly audit costs based on the ICC's average market share, based upon total bulk bill market share minutes for the period under investigation. For 1991, the period shall be from May 15 through December 31. For 1992, the period shall be the full calendar year. The audit costs shall be listed as a separate line item on the standard access bill to the ICCs.

Each ICC shall pay the AECA for its share of the audit costs according to the provisions set forth in Section 2.4.1 (B)(2)(a). If an ICC is late in paying or refuses to pay its audit bill, the general AECA penalty and late payment provisions of Section 2.4.1 (B)(2)(b) - (g) will apply. AECA may also seek reimbursement through the bonding/deposit mechanism provided under Section 2.4.1 (A) of the AECA tariff. The AECA shall use the funds collected from the ICCs to pay the audit costs. (T)
