8 AFFIDAVIT OF CAPTAIN LAREN ZAGER

9 Captain Laren J. Zager, being first duly sworn, deposes
10 and states as follows:

11 1. This affidavit is a supplement to my affidavit dated
12 August 30, 1994. I am still the Commander of Staff Services for
13 the Anchorage Police Department ("APD").

14 2. APD has maintained a five consecutive work day, eight
15 hours per day work schedule for Uniformed Field Service Traffic and
16 Patrol officers since its implementation September 1, 1994.

17 3. As my original affidavit indicated, APD anticipated that
18 adoption of the five/eights work schedule would lead to increased
19 staffing per day and a significant reduction in overtime and
20 premium pay expenses as compared to the four/tens schedule then in
21 effect. Both of these expectations have been realized. While the
22 Department has also increased manpower, further reducing overtime
23 costs and added to staffing on a per shift basis, even when these
24 considerations are factored out, the adoption of the five/eights

1 work schedule by itself has saved hundreds of thousands of dollars
2 and increased police presence in the field as compared to the
3 four/tens schedule then in effect.
