<b><u>Silver Salmon:</u></b>	Fly Rod:	8 or 9 wt. Sage or equivalent
	Fly Lines:	Floating and Type 3 or Type 6 Sink Tips
	Leaders:	6' 10-12# Test
	Flies:	Purple Spectra Buggers, Flash Flies, Fat Freddie's & Egg Sucking Leaches
<b><u>Red Salmon:</u></b>	Fly Rod:	7 or 8 wt. Sage or equivalent
	Fly lines:	Floating
	Leaders:	10' 10# Test
	Flies:	Sockeye Orange, Comet, Montana Brassie, Mickey Finns, Ginger Bunny & Polar Shrimp
<b><u>Rainbow Trout &amp; Dolly Varden:</u></b>	Fly Rod:	7 or 8 wt. Sage or equivalent
	Fly Lines:	<b>Floating</b> and Type 6 or Wet Tip V Sink Tips or Teeny Nymph Lines
	Leaders:	10' 10-12# Test (Floating); 6' 10-12# Test (Sinking)
	Flies:	Woolhead Sculpins, Woolly Buggers, Egg Sucking Leaches, Battle Creeks, Ginger Bunny Bugs, White Bunny Bugs, White Woolly Buggers and <b>Glo-Bugs</b>
