Welcome to Paradise Block & Concrete's, Mahi Mahi Road gravel pit. To make your visit a safe one, please follow the safety procedures listed below:

## A. GENERAL SAFETY

- 1. Keep away from moving equipment.
- 2. Observe all traffic patterns.
- 3. Never turn your back on moving equipment.
- 4. Stay in site of equipment operators.
- 5. Stay away from conveyor belts and moving machinery.
- 6. Do not get on or off of moving equipment.
- 7. Do not smoke in 'No Smoking Areas' or near flammable or combustible material.

## **B. PIT AREAS**

- 1. Never stand, park or work on the top of bank edges where there is danger of caving.
- 2. Never park or stand at the base of highwall banks, slides or falls of materials may occur.
- 3. Never work between equipment or machinery and the pit wall or bank where the equipment or machinery would hinder your escape from falls or slides from the bank.
- 4. Make certain by signal or other means that equipment operators are aware of your presence.
- 5. Do not park or stand behind equipment due to the operator's limited visibility.
- 6. Do not enter flagged areas unless authorized.
