RETIRED

(Retain MSDS for a minimum of 1 Year)

Remember to notify miners 3 months prior to disposing of the MSDS.
(Document date/method of notification)

CHEMICAL INVENTORY

Inventory and log all chemicals located on-site.

Make sure you have an MSDS for each chemical.

Indicate on log which chemicals are hazardous.

Document all changes to inventory:

- New products
- Deleted products
- Process changes
- Etc.

HAZCOMM CERTIFICATES

All miners must be trained prior to assignment and before exposure to chemicals.

Remember to Document:

- ✓ Initial HazComm Training
- ✓ Site-Specific HazComm Training
Physical & Health hazards of each chemical)
- ✓ Training dates/methods for newly added, removed, chemicals, changes in process, changes in chemicals, etc.
- ✓ Dates when miners were notified that a chemical was deleted from inventory, removed from use and site, MSDS retired. Also document means used to communicate this information.
