

General Information

Your pet has just undergone a procedure requiring anesthesia, therefore, special attention will be needed over the next few days.

Anesthesia can make your animal nauseous. If your pet vomits remove access to food until the following morning. Your pet may be sleepy for 24-48 hours. If vomiting or grogginess persists, please call the clinic.

Important Points To Remember

1. Keep your pet in a warm quiet environment for the next 24 hours. It may be disoriented, so allow it outside only for short periods of time and only under close supervision.
2. Feed it lightly (about 1/4 to 1/2 normal amount) the first evening home, unless it is extremely groggy, then feed nothing.
3. Limit water to small amounts at a time. Have a small amount (1/4 cup or an ice cube) available for your pet.
